**SWAT** (Simply Waiting A Turn) i.e. “stand-by” service volunteers. You are willing to be contacted about specific requests as the needs arise.

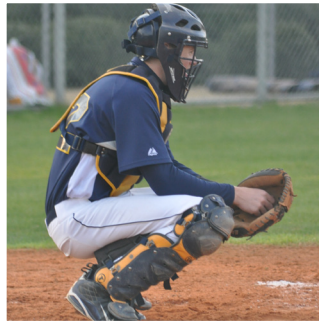
