

King Arthur and the Knights of the Round Table
Web Quest

This year you will be reading British literature. It has many stories with which you are already familiar especially stories about King Arthur. You are going to read T. H. White's book *Sword in the Stone*. It has four books, but you are only responsible to read **Book 1**. King Arthur is a cornerstone in English literature, and it is a source for stories and poems and literary allusions throughout the literature.

When you finish reading Book 1, "The Sword in the Stone," you are to complete the following web quest. (You may watch Disney's movie "Sword in the Stone," but you will be **missing many details** that will help you **pass the test in August**.) This assignment is to help you learn about the history of King Arthur and recognize the characters associated with his story. Your answers and responses are to be typed and printed on a separate sheet of paper and submitted on the first day of school.

Your assignment:

1. Read T. H. White's **Once and Future King, Book 1, "the Sword in the Stone."** You may read the story on line in PDF form or you may want to purchase the book.
2. The web quest.
 - The web quest is to be typed on a Word document and printed to turn in.
 - Make sure to answer each question. Some questions are direct/ specific answers and others are in paragraph form. Read the directions for each questions carefully.
 - Make sure to clearly distinguish between each section of the quest.
 - Format is optional, but should be organized and easy to read with questions (written out) and responses clearly indicated.
